The finals will be played on a Round Robin basis and **bowling will commence at 9.30**. In each discipline, teams have been put into Groups of four and will play 3 games each to find a Group winner.

Group winners will be decided on points won, then on shots for and if necessary shots against. 2 Points will be awarded for a win, 1 Point will be awarded for a drawn game. The group winners will then play off in the finals.

English & Suffolk Carpet Bowls Rules will apply.

Please be available to play 10 minutes before your first game and arrive at your mat on time, as there will be penalties for late arrival. **Up to 2 minutes late you will lose 1 end and 2 shots, up to 4 minutes late, 2 ends and 4 shots. After 5 minutes the game will be forfeit, with a score of 2 points and 9 shots.**

Each bowler will have 4 woods in Singles, 3 woods in Pairs, 2 woods in Fours. Games will still be 7 ends and timed as usual with the whistle being blown: –

Singles 20 minutes,

Pairs 25 minutes,

Fours 40 minutes.

An end will be deemed to have been started once the jack has been placed.

Format and times for the Finals will be given on the day but will depend on which teams qualify.

This year again, several players have been very successful and qualified in more than one discipline. This means that some players will be bowling on the same carpet more than once. Therefore during the lunch break 2 carpets will be removed and the remaining ones moved.

Rules for missing/replacement players

Singles: If a qualifying individual(s) is unable to take part in Finals Day, then the group games they would have played are void.

Pairs: If just one individual in any pair is unable to take part in Finals Day, then that individual can be replaced by an individual from the same club(s), providing that they have not already played in that event's Qualification Day. If more than one individual in any pair is unable to take part in Finals Day, then that pair or triple will not be permitted to compete. The group games they would have played are void.

Fours: If one or two individuals in any four are unable to take part in Finals Day, then they can be replaced by an individual(s) from the same club(s), providing that they have not already played in that event's Qualification Day. If more than two individuals in any four are unable to take part in Finals Day, then that four will not be permitted to compete. The group games they would have played are void.
