Minutes of the Executive Committee Meeting of the Suffolk Carpet Bowls Association held at Needham Market Community Centre on Monday 1st September 2025 – 7:30pm

1. Apologies for absence: Sally Goodrich **SG**, Jim Goodrich **JG**, Richard Sago **RS** (Match Secretary), Jane Sago **JS**

Peter Dent **PDE** has formally resigned from the committee. The committee shared that he will be missed and has been good with us throughout his tenure.

2. Approval of previous minutes:

The minutes of the meeting held on 30th June 2025 were proposed by **FW**, seconded by **SCG** and approved and signed by the Chair.

3. Matters arising:

AG: Date at the top was the 19th May and should have been 30th June. No other matters arising.

4. Chairman's Report:

AG: Good evening, friends.

Good to see you all and I hope you all have had a good holiday. It is about now the work starts in earnest again, so let's go.

My apologies but I need to start with some not so good news. On 11th August at home with family Celia Cobbold peacefully passed away. Sincere sympathy and thoughts go to David and the family, and their friends.

There is one other thing for me to do, and that is to thank those who have been e-mailing me and working towards the 40th Birthday Party. I thank you for your work towards this common goal.

5. Treasurer's Report:

PD: All the clubs who were expected to renew their memberships and insurance, have done so. We are down 3 on last year due to clubs having closed, all of which had let us know at the time.

The year's other big transaction is for the Nationals, all of which has come in and been paid to Potters. We will have a contingent of 43 people going this year, including supporters, up from 35 last year.

Overall, the accounts are in line with where we were at the same time last year, so we're on target to make sure that we at least break even.

6. Match Secretary's Report:

RS (sent prior to the meeting): Summer league seems to have gone ok with no problems, hopefully Paul has finals night under control. We are happy to do tea/coffee and biscuits. Could someone else do the raffle if you want one as with 70 players it should be worth it.

Winter league had a couple of complaints re travelling for some teams, I think this is now sorted. Several fixture lists have been sent in so most clubs seem happy. Personally, I think the leagues are well balanced.

It looks as though it's time to get entry forms together again for the fours - 16th November. Are we happy to leave entry fees as the same as last year?

PD: No need to change fees.

SCG Agreed to email **RS** to say that she had the tea/coffee stock and would sort raffle with them. **NJ**: Cup draw was done and league info was sent out. Emails had been received to discuss issues with the travelling for some teams and both have now been rectified.

7. Captain's Report:

SG: After agreement from the committee Colin Felingham has been appointed as a selector, as there had been a vacancy for some time. The selectors and I have had a get together, it was nice to welcome Colin (very brave with 3 women). I Have sorted Team Bowl and Nationals and will let players know. We discussed Trials and as yet don't know what format it will take.

8.ECBA Report:

NJ: The next ECBA meeting is online on Saturday 20th September, **NJ** to attend & will report back at our next meeting.

Before then is the ECBA Triples on Sunday 14th September at Coxhoe Village Hall, hosted by Durham Carpet Bowls Association.

Looking further ahead, the ECBA Nationals is being held at Potters (Hopton) over the long weekend of 24 to 27 October.

10. Media Secretary's Report:

AP: As always, the Summer months have been quiet. Following is holding steady at mid-330s but I'm hopeful that it will increase during the winter months when the posting becomes more frequent.
